

RDAQ Organisational Corporate Membership

RDAQ supports rural doctors and the communities they serve within Queensland and nationally through the Rural Doctors Association of Australia.

What is the difference between Organisational Corporate Membership and Associate Membership:

- ***Associate membership*** is for non-doctor individuals who wish to actively support RDAQ's objectives and priorities and enjoy the individual member benefits other than voting rights. Associate members might be registered health professionals other than doctors, live in rural communities, work in local government or are otherwise committed to rural health in Queensland. Membership is attached to the individual associate member. RDAQ can progress concerns and advocacy on behalf of associate members.
- ***Organisational corporate membership*** is for companies, associations or other legal entities who are organisationally committed to progressing rural health in Queensland. A nominated representative is allocated conference discounts. Again the membership category does not enjoy voting rights, however, attracts organisational benefits including marketing opportunities and discounts. Membership is attached to the organisation and is a great way to support RDAQ's activities.
